## **Course Overview**

### **Why choose this course?**

The Foundation Year (level 3) is designed to equip applicants who do not have the required qualifications to enter directly onto level 4, with a robust toolkit of the academic, digital and personal skills required for successful study in Higher Education and with an understanding of, and insight to, the business discipline.

Successful completion of the Foundation Year will allow progression onto level 4 of BA (Hons) Business Management or any degree in the Business School portfolio. This exciting and innovative general business programme is designed for students who want to embark on an in-depth study of business and management to develop analysis and evaluation skills that can be applied to real-world situations.

### **What's unique about this course?**

- Overall satisfaction University of Wolverhampton outperformed the sector-wide scores by 13.6% NSS 2022.
- Accredited by The Chartered Management Institute (CMI) is the Chartered Body for Management and Leadership disciplines.
- One of the main benefits of studying a CMI accredited qualification is that it enhances student employability; the body's research suggests that 58% of graduates from a CMI Accredited degree were in professional roles within six months of degree completion.

# BA (Hons) Digital Marketing Management with Foundation Year

In this course, you will acquire a knowledge of contemporary Digital Marketing tools and techniques, including Marketing Strategy, Digital Marketing, search engine and social media marketing, Marketing consultancy, web development and design, search engine optimisation (SEO), big data, branding, sustainability, consumer behaviour, and ethical influence and responsibility.

## Course Overview

The Foundation Year (Level 3) equips applicants with a robust toolkit of academic, digital, and personal skills necessary for successful study in higher education, along with an understanding of the business discipline. Successful completion of the foundation year allows progression to Level 4 of the BA (Hons) Digital Marketing Management. A practical and practice-based programme, this course will equip you with the agile, reflexive and critical thinking skills which are vital for success in modern organisations.
